



COMMITMENT TO LEARNING RESULTS

The Regional School Unit-24 (RSU) Board (RSUB) hereby adopts Maine's System of Learning Results (MSLR).

The MSLR is intended to serve as a foundation for education reform and to promote and provide assessment of student learning, accountability and equity. The RSUB recognizes that the legislative intent of the MSLR is to provide children with schools that reflect high expectations and create conditions where these expectations can be met.

The RSUB understands that implementation of the MSLR and the mandate to provide all students with equitable opportunities to meet the content standards of the MSLR have broad implications for the RSU, including curriculum, budget, professional development, student assessment, professional evaluation, and graduation requirements. Therefore, the RSUB is committed to examining all policies and practices to ensure that they are consistent with the intent and goals of the MSLR as they move forward with the formation of the RSU. This will require a concerted and coordinated effort involving the RSUB, the Superintendent, administrators, teachers, parents, students, and all RSU communities.

The RSU directs the Superintendent to monitor the continuing evolution and development of the MSLR, and to ensure the intent and goals of changes to the MSLR is supported by any and all appropriate administrative procedures as required.

The RSUB further directs the Superintendent to report to the RSUB on a regular basis on the requirements, and the RSU's progress toward implementing, of any/all changes/updates to the MSLR.
