



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY PASSES

To enhance public support of Regional School Unit 24 (RSU) Co-Curricular Activities (CCA), in addition to providing guidelines for the issuing of passes, the RSU Board (RSUB) establishes the following procedures.

- A. RSUB members will be issued a photo ID card by the Superintendents Office at the time of their election, to be valid for the period of time they are elected to serve. This ID card will serve as identification for entrance to all CCA's, and for entering all RSU schools. RSUB members must sign in with the school office any time they are visiting schools.
- B. Upon request, City Council Members, City Managers and Selectmen from towns within the RSU will be issued a free "All Sports Pass" valid for the current school year.
- C. Upon request, members of the press will be issued a pass valid for all CCAs for the current school year. (Normally admitted by personal recognition)
- D. Upon request, any Senior Citizen sixty-two (62) years of age and over, and all former RSUB members will be issued a free lifetime "All Sports Pass".
- E. Yearly "All Sports Passes" are available for purchase for persons under the age of sixty two (62). Passes serve as admission to all RSU home sporting events at all RSU schools.
- F. Students may purchase "All RSU Sports Passes" at the student price.
- G. RSU staff will be admitted by personal recognition or by showing their faculty ID.
- H. Passes issued by the Maine Principals' Association (MPA) will be honored as admission to all CCAs.
- I. All CCA admission fees are to be approved by both RSU high school Building Administrators (BA).

NOTES:

Passes are available at both Ellsworth High School (EHS) and Sumner Memorial High School (SMHS) offices.

Passes must be presented at the time of entry into the CCA, and will serve as admission only for the person named on the pass. RSU passes are valid for RSU-sponsored sports activities only. (Not for MPA sponsored events)

Each high school assistant BA will design their passes, which will be a “back to back type” design, with one side having the Sumner Memorial HS design, the other side with an Ellsworth HS design. These passes will be approved by the BA’s of each high school.
