



SCHOOL PHYSICIAN

State Law requires Regional School Unit-24 (RSU) to have a School Physician.

For the purposes of this policy “parent” refers to a student’s parent and/or legal guardian.

The appointment of the School Physician will be for a period of one (1) year, unless such appointment is required to fill the remainder of a vacated term. The Superintendent will recommend a school physician to be appointed by the RSU Board (RSUB) at its annual organizational meeting.

The school physician shall advise the administrative unit on school health issues, policies and practices and may also perform any other health-related functions assigned by the board.

The school physician may not treat any student examined under the duties assigned by this, or any other RSU policy unless he/she is the student’s personal physician.
