



STUDENT AUTOMOBILE USE AND PARKING

Regional School Unit-24 (RSU) High School students may be allowed to use automobiles and other motorized vehicles for transportation to and from school. Students may not leave school grounds during the school day without permission from a parent or guardian.

All vehicles so used will be properly parked in the school parking lot and may not be moved or entered during school hours, prior to dismissal of the student, without the permission of the Building Administrator (BA) or Assistant Building Administrator (ABA).

Students who do not observe the RSU rules regarding use of vehicles or who do not operate them on RSU property in a safe and prudent manner are subject to losing the privilege to bring their vehicles to any RSU school. All vehicles operated on RSU property are required to be in compliance with all applicable State of Maine motor vehicle laws. Violators may be reported to law enforcement officials.

The RSU Board (RSUB) does not condone students transporting anyone other than the owner (operator) during the day. However, this is the responsibility of the student(s) and/or parent(s) involved, and NOT the RSU.

The RSUB assumes NO responsibility in regard to student vehicle operation off RSU property.

Individual high school BA's may control/assign parking at their school, however with three (3) schools involved and with students possibly attending all schools, this MUST be a cooperative effort between all BA's to ensure all students have equal opportunity in regards to vehicle operation at RSU schools.

BA's must consider that non-RSU students also attend our schools and must be able to comply with our vehicle rules.

The RSUB discourages BA's from charging students to park on Public (RSU) property as a matter of principal.
